

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADVERTISEMENT CONTRACT: AUCTION
ON 03.04.2019 AT 10.030HRS.

1. The amount will be received in advance on quarterly basis.
2. The decision on the offers would be given by the Chief Executive Officer/Cantt. Board.
3. The highest bidder will be required to execute an agreement within 07 days after the sanction of highest bid by the Cantonment Board, Ambala.
4. The earnest money will be deposit Rs.100000/- by cash and three month licence fee as security cash deposit at the fall of hammer.
5. The amount of Rs.100000/- of security will be refunded after the tenure of contract without interest and if during the tenure of contract any loss or damage is caused to the Cantonment Board. The Cantonment Board will have a right to deduct the same from the security.
6. The highest bidder will have to deposit 03 month advance licence fee after the fall of the hammer.If the bidder fails to deposit the same, the bid shall be liable to be rejected & the CEO shall call for fresh bids by carrying re-auction.
7. The highest bidder if at any time is found issuing more then approval sites in the Cantonment area, the hoarding will be removed by the Cantt Board Staff without any notice, and damages/penalty would be charged accordingly.

9.
